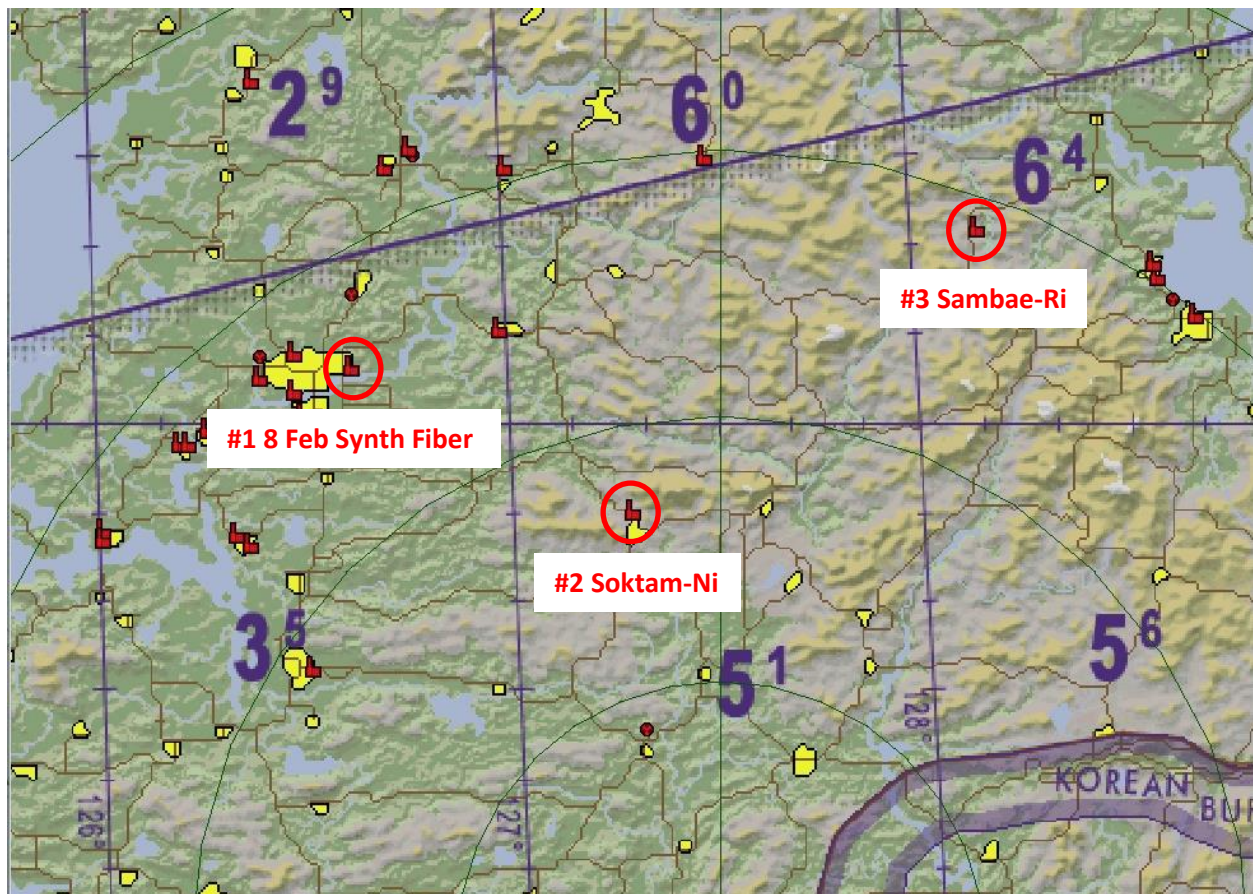


Operation Cyberbully

Classified and Urgent

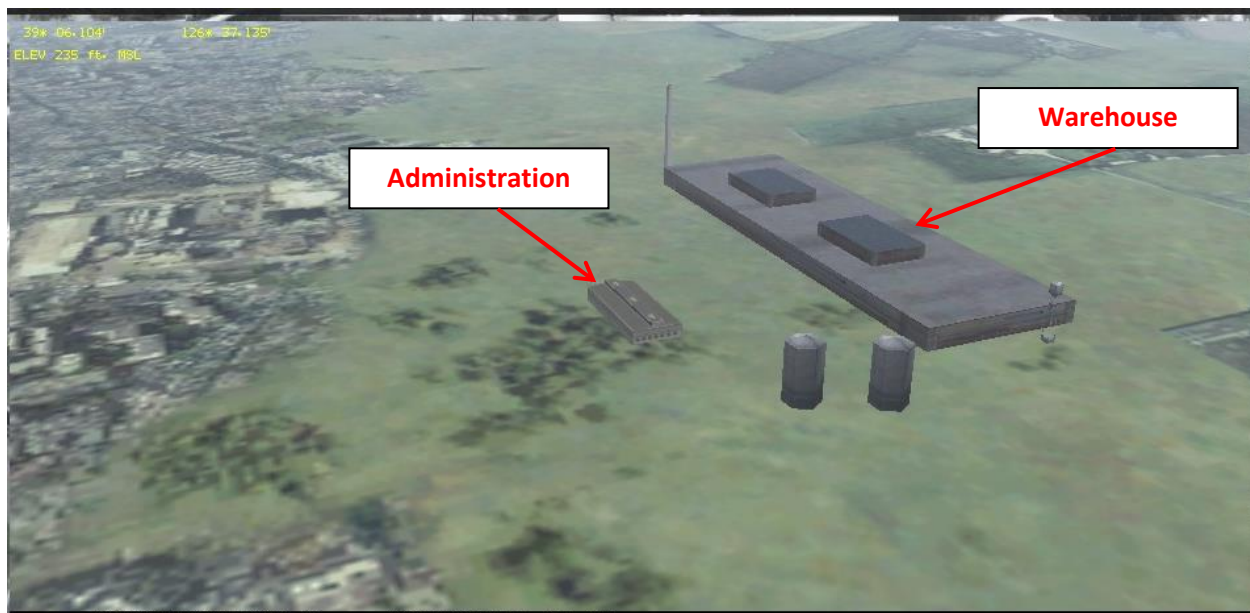
North Korea's recent cyberattacks on U.S. based companies has become a threat to national security. The NSA has tracked recent cyberattacks on U.S. based companies to North Korea. The White House has directed the CIA and the Pentagon to take any measures necessary to eliminate the threat of future cyberattacks. The CIA has identified three cyber-hacking locations in North Korea: #1 east of Cheonan, #2 north of Soktam-Ni, and #3 at Sambae-Ri. The administrative building at the 8 Feb Synth Fiber complex is the hub of the operation and must be destroyed immediately. The three warehouses house scores of computers and highly skilled hackers.

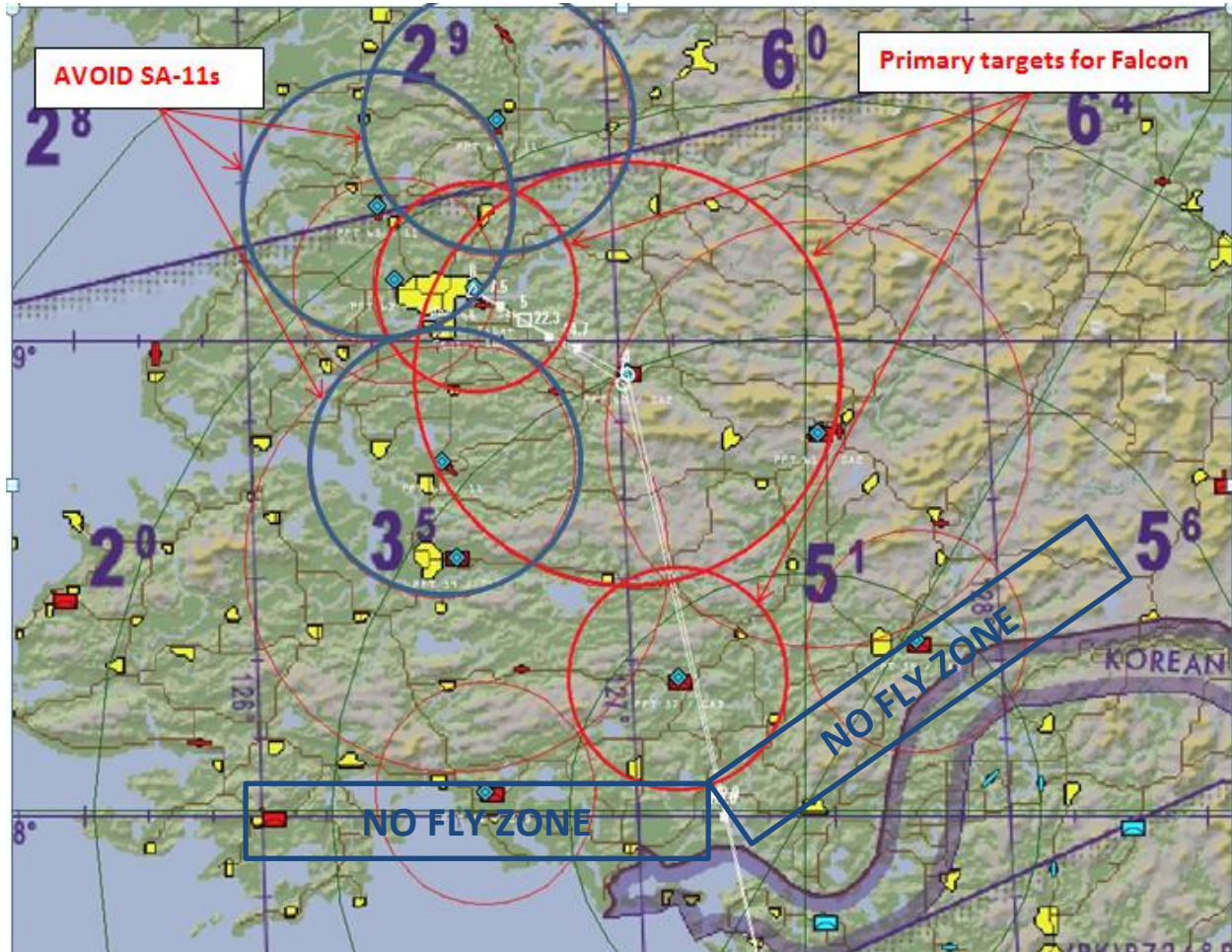
SA-2, SA-3, SA-6, and SA-11 squadrons located near the target.

Enemy Activity

Mig-23 squadrons out of Onjin AB, Hyon-Ni AB, and Hwangju AB are enforcing a “No Fly Zone” north of the DMZ. Mig-21’s out of Haeju AB and Koksan AB are flying routine patrols along the DMZ. Mig-29As are on alert status at Koksan AB.

Rules of Engagement

You are to engage any enemy force threatening the success of the mission—on the ground or in the air. Positive identification, either visual or AWACs, is required. The primary target is located in an urban center; therefore, all efforts must be made to minimize collateral damage.

Weather Conditions

Fair weather. Cloud base is 30,000 feet; con layer is 28,000. Widespread fog is rolling in and is expected over the area and during recovery.
